WHY CSOs NETWORK?

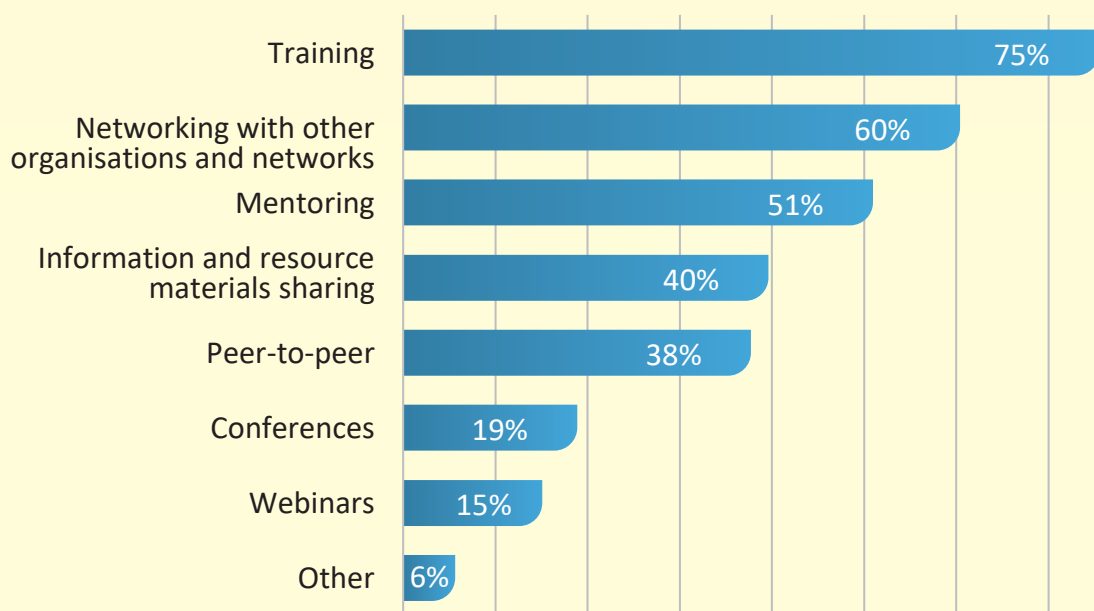

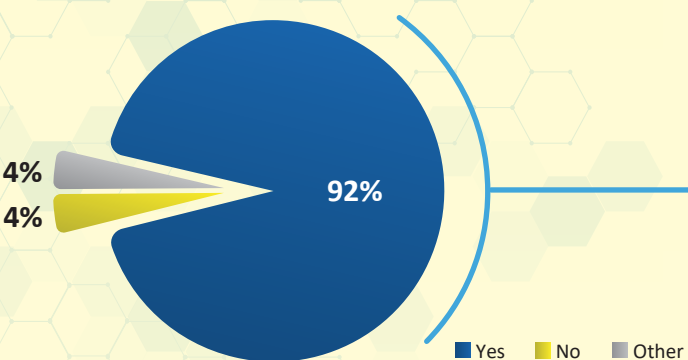

55% with grassroots organisations

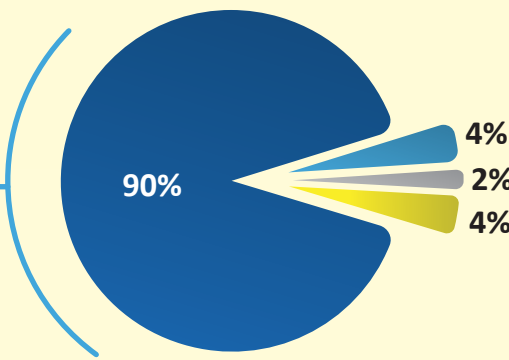
25% with global networks

Does your network/EU-CSF project consider the EU integration in the work?

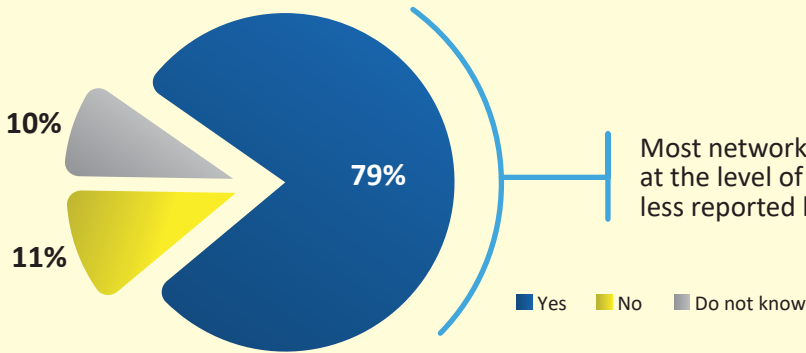
Networks create documents and analyses on the situation in the region, which then serve as tools to advocate in front of both national-level governments and EU institutions.

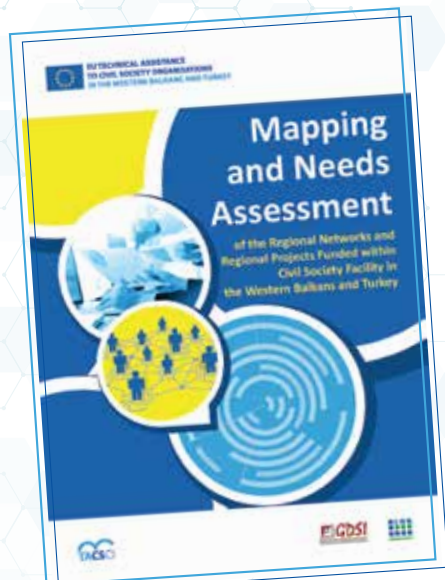
GENDER EQUALITY
