What is it?

- Established in 1949 by leading EU figures such as **Salvador de Madariaga**, **Winston Churchill**, **Paul Henri Spaak** and **Alcide de Gasperi** in the wake of the first Congress of the European Movement in The Hague in 1948.
- The idea was to establish an institute where university graduates from different European countries could **study and live together** in preparation for careers in European cooperation and integration.
- The first and oldest postgraduate institute of EU affairs.
- Two campuses: in **Bruges** and in **Natolin** (Warsaw; 1992)
- International community of more than 50 nationalities
- Bilingual institution: English - French
- Extensive network of alumni in Brussels and beyond (17.000 alumni)

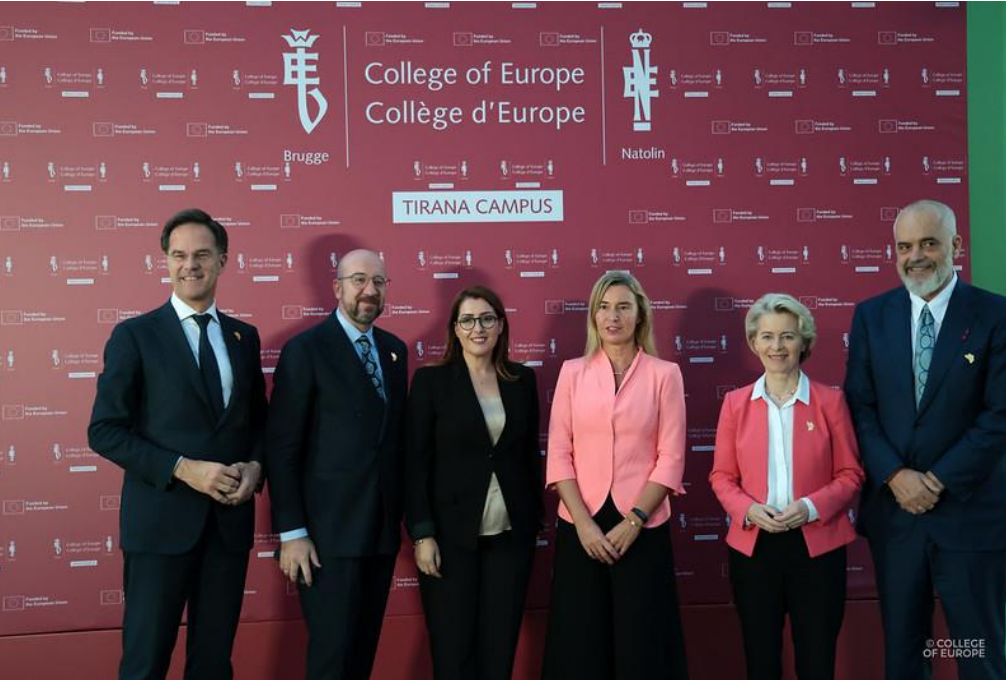

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- › All applicants to the College of Europe must hold a relevant university degree;
- › Admission requires either a Bologna Master's degree / 240 ECTS;
- › Exceptionally holders of a bachelor's degree may also be eligible;
- › Fluent English (C1) and basic French (A1) are required
